1) REMOVE EXISTING BUMPER

Begin removing your vehicle's existing Rear bumper. We show how to do this in another video over at www.fishboneoffroad.tv



Remove the sensors and sensor wiring harness. Remove the license plate bracket and lights. Remove license plate lights. Remove the exhaust caps.

2) ASSEMBLE

If applicable, remove the blind spot sensor brackets and install the factory sensors as shown.



If you have them, install your 3x3 pod lights here according to the manufacturers instructions.





Install your factory license plate bracket, spare tire guide, and trailer plug.
